Why Croatia? - food



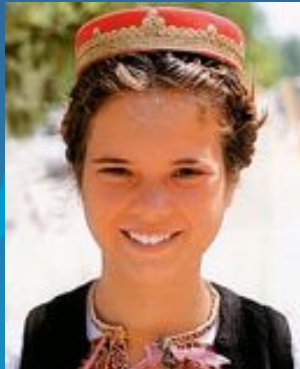
- Seafood on the coast is great

Why Croatia? - history

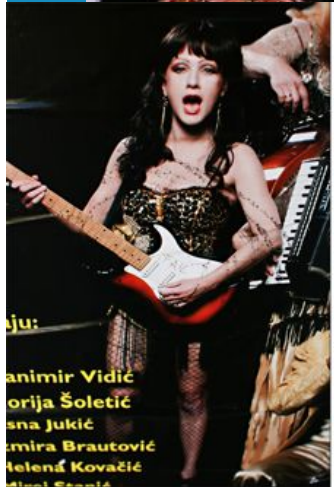


- Towns from Roman times - Split

- Similar population



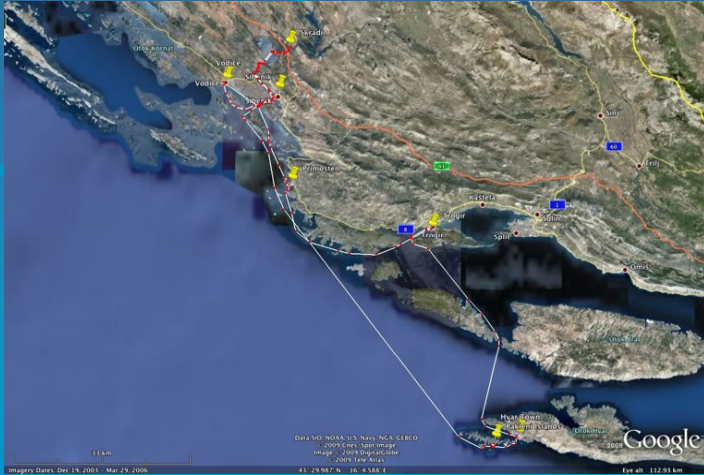
Croatia - a few facts!



- It gets dark about an hour earlier than Ireland - around 19:00 Sept
- It gets bright around 06:30
- Make use of daylight
- The Croats love the Irish!
- Beer: good and costs €1.90-3.80
- House wine from €10 per litre
- Marinas are good but expensive!
- Dubrovnik is expensive - not as much as Ireland!
- Islands are less expensive

Euro from Jul 2013

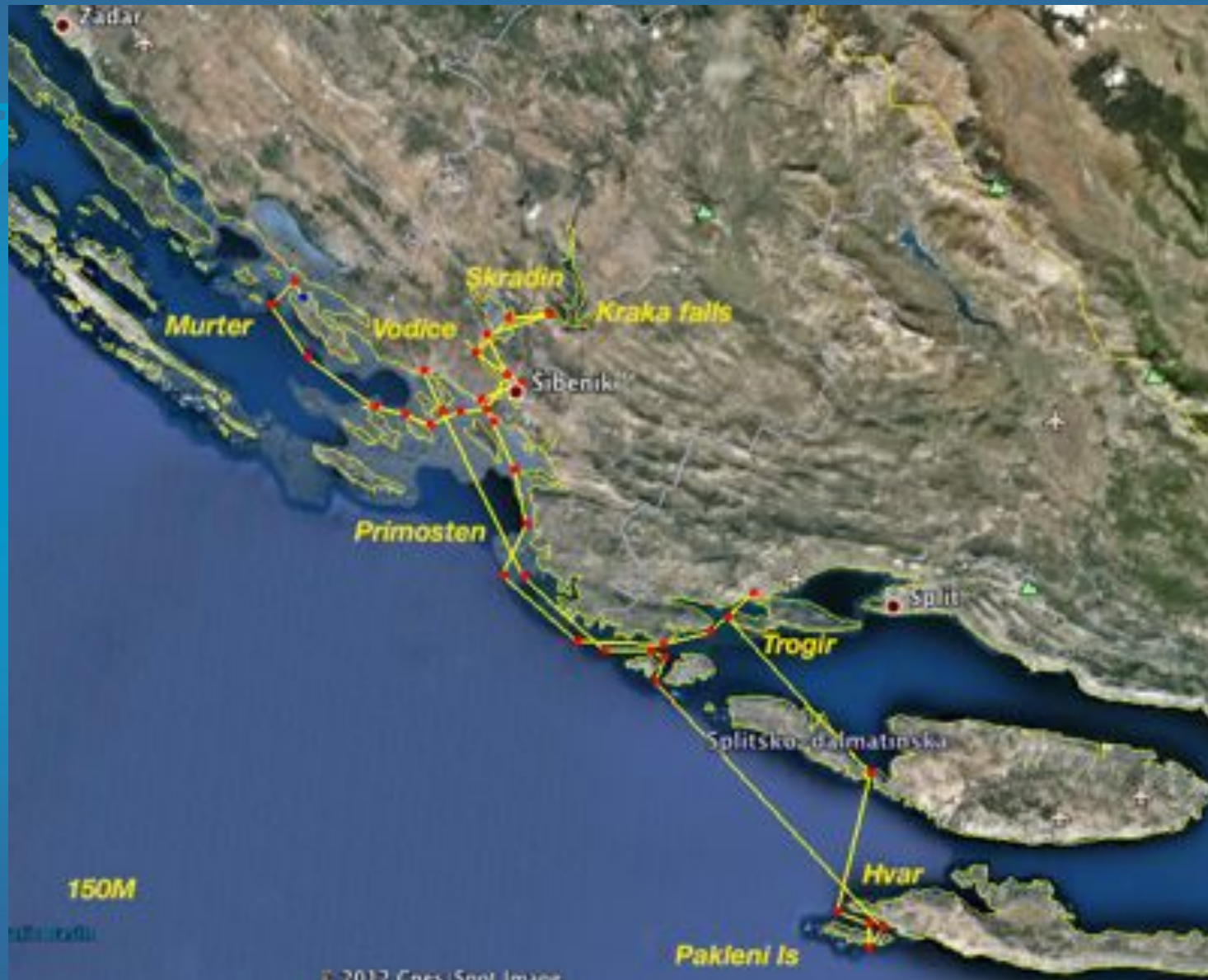

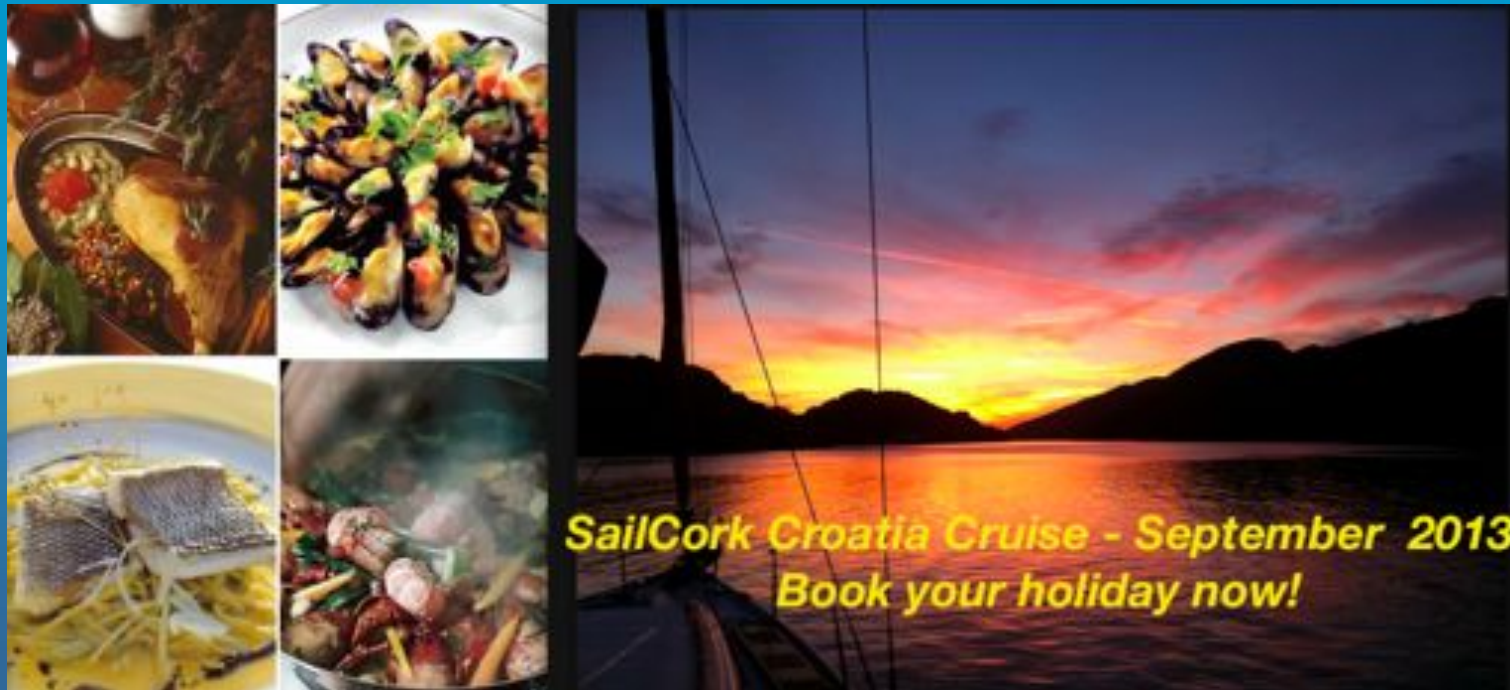

Croatia 2013- suggested itinerary

- *Sun* Arrival Dubrovnik - sail to Kolpcep in Elaphite Islands
- *Mon* Kolocep- Cavtat to Mljet Island
- *Tue* Mljet - Korcula *Wed* Korcula - Lastavo
- *Thur* Lastavo - Mljet *Fri* Mljet - Ston
- *Sat* Ston - Dubrovnik *Sun* Dep Dubrovnik

Croatia 2013- Dubrovnik-Elaphite Islands Sun

Short sail from marina in Dubrovnik to the island of Koločep (6 miles)



Croatia 2013- Elaphite Islands - Mljet Mon

Sail to the Old City (Dubrovnik and anchor off for breakfast then on to Cavtat for lunch and on to Mali Stolj (Mljet) for the night



Croatia 2013- Mljet - Korcula Tue

Sail from Mali Skolj and anchor at Prozura for breakfast and on to the small island of Badija for lunch and to the marina at Korcula (birthplace of Marco Polo)



Croatia 2013- Korčula- Lastovo Wed

Head to an anchorage on south of Korčula for breakfast and swim and on to Lastovo (only opened to tourism recently) explore the island and moor at Zaplopatica for the night



Croatia 2013- Lastovo- Mljet Thur

Sail from Lastovo through the islands off Mljet to the Roman town of Pomena and explore the area



Croatia 2013- Mljet - Ston Fri

Sail the beautiful north shore of Mljet and on to the historic town of Ston with it's amazing walls



Croatia 2013- Ston - Dubrovnik Sat

Sail from Ston to the Elaphite Islands for breakfast and on to Dubrovnik - explore Dubrovnik in afternoon and meet for last night dinner in Dubrovnik restaurant



Croatia 2013- Sunday

Breakfast at Marina and then to airport and flight back to Ireland!
